 - (viii) Based in Samoa (desirable); and
 - (ix) Languages - excellent level of written and oral English. Samoan is an asset.
5. The IT Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection ("QCBS") method consistent with the Government Procurement Guidelines for Consultancy Services.
